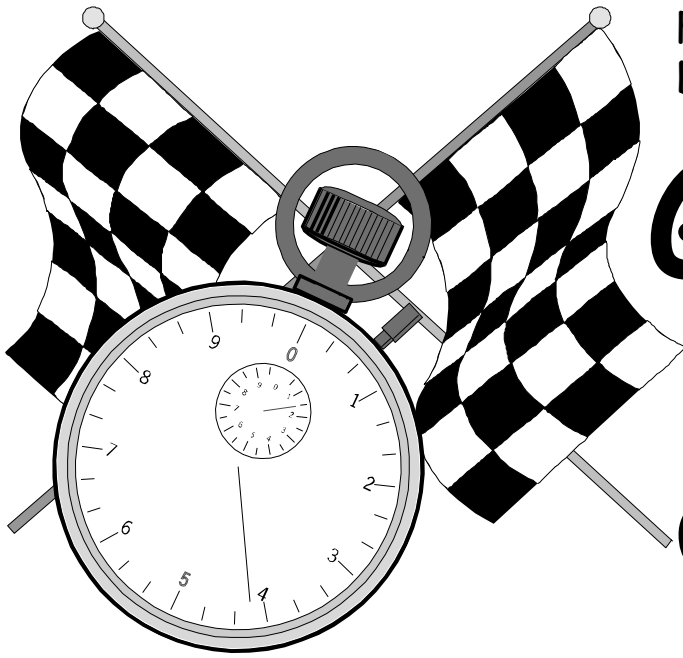

SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

All events are spectator events at Grattan Raceway, Grattan, Michigan

(Sanction #06-N-28-S)

1. This is a Spectator Event and will be conducted in strict compliance with the current General Competition Rules and Amendments, except as modified by these Supplemental Regulations. The Stewards of the Meeting reserve the right to alter the schedule of events for good and sufficient reason.
2. DRIVER ELIGIBILITY - All drivers must have a valid/current SCCA National license and current SCCA membership. Any driver whose license or membership is in the process of renewal, or needs confirmation of such, must contact the Chief Registrar prior to 9:00 PM, Wednesday before the event, for National Office verification. A fee of \$5.00 will be charged.
3. The entry fee includes 1 driver and 3 crewmembers. Additional crew and/or guest passes may be purchased for \$10.00 each at Registration. No passes will be sold unless the driver has specified the crew/guest's name. A \$25.00 collection fee will be added for any check refused for any reason. For the early entry fee, your entry with payment enclosed and must be postmarked on or before Wednesday, May 3. Cancellations received after Wednesday, May 10 may receive a full or partial refund.
4. NO SHOW - NO CANCELLATION = NO REFUND.
5. NO PETS are allowed in inner paddock inside the track; pets are allowed in outside paddock (outside track).
6. National numbers will be held until May 1, 2006. You will be notified if you do not receive your first number choice.
7. There are no waived classes for 2006. For all classes, if the driver has a current SCCA helmet sticker and the car has an annual tech and no notations in the logbook since the annual tech, bring helmet, all driver gear, completed logbook and completed tech form to tech. See schedule for scale availability.
8. Competition vehicles may be impounded during/after practice/qualifying/race at the discretion of the Chief Steward in addition to the GCR requirements. The driver must remain at impound and may have one additional person present.
9. Once the false grid is closed, all track entrance and exits must be made from Pit lane. Grid is to be cleared at the 'one minute signal' of all crew.
10. Sound limit of 103 decibels.
11. Unless modified by the Official Schedule, NO race engine may be started or run from 6:00PM to 9:00AM, except Race Group 1 may run at idle after 8:15AM.
12. Functioning transponders are required for all cars. A limited number of transponders will be available for rent on a first come, first served basis.
13. Only 1 utility or support vehicle per competitor will be allowed in the Paddock area. All other vehicles and trailers must be parked in outer paddock areas. The use of any motorized/non-motorized two-, three- or four-wheeled mini-vehicles is permitted; motorized operation requires a valid drivers license and non-motorized operators must be at least 12 years of age. No skateboards, roller blades, or roller skates are permitted in the paddock. Check with track authorities regarding safety equipment required for after hours bicycling on the track. Riding on the exterior coachwork of a vehicle is prohibited.
14. Trophies will be awarded per the GCR or better.
15. The following are track radio frequencies; other radio transmissions are prohibited on these frequencies:
151.625, 151.925, 154.600, 154.640
16. Driver Information is located behind Tech in the Tech Garage. Sound readings will be posted at Tech. Provisional qualifying times and provisional results will be posted on the timing tower. Trophies and Results will be available at Driver Information once the results are official.
17. Camping is available for a fee. Gas, Water, and Air are available at the track. There is a \$20.00 disposal charge for each tire left at the track. The concession stand will be open for breakfast at 8:00AM.
18. Friday practice is a track activity and is NOT sanctioned by Fort Wayne Region SCCA, Detroit Region SCCA, or SCCA.

MINOR WAIVERS

Previous permanent waivers and pink forms/cards are NO LONGER VALID

Children coming to the track must be accompanied by a parent, or buy a spectator pass if applicable, or have a waiver SIGNED BY a parent/legal guardian AND WITNESSED by SCCA Registrar or notary public.
